## TOWN OF BROCKWAY ORDINANCE NO. 35 A

## AN ORDINANCE REGARDING JUNK VECHICLES AND/OR ALL JUNK IN THE TOWN OF BROCKWAY.

WHEREAS, it is in the public health, safety and general welfare that certain regulations be adopted regarding junk vehicles and other junk in the Town,

NOW THEREFORE, THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF BROCKWAY, JACKSON COUNTY, WISCONSIN DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. No person shall keep, house, store or place on premises owned, leased or controlled by that person in the Town of Brockway junk, such as scrap iron, junk vehicles, junk machinery, junk trailers, bottles, jugs, rags, broken glass, paper of any kind, scrap metal, or anything that might otherwise be considered junk or waste.

For purposes of this section, "junk vehicle" means any of the following:

(a) A vehicle which is incapable of operation or use upon a highway and which has no resale value except as a source of parts or scrap.

(b) A vehicle in which the estimated cost of repairing the vehicle to make it roadworthy exceeds its fair market value.

Section 2. Whenever the Town Officer shall find any such junk vehicle or other junk kept, housed, stored or placed on premises within the Town of Brockway, he shall serve notice on the property owner and/or owner of such junk of to remove the same within fifteen (15) days of said notice. If any junk vehicle or other junk is not removed within fifteen (15) days of such notice, the Town shall cause such junk vehicle or other junk to be removed and the cost of such removal shall be charged to the property from which it is removed, such charge to be entered upon the tax roll as a special assessment as provided by the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 3. Upon removal by the Town, the junk vehicle or other junk shall be stored in a junk or salvage yard or other suitable place for thirty (30) days, and the owner thereof shall be so notified by mailing such notice to the last known address of such owner. The Town may dispose of the junk vehicle or other junk unless the owner claims such junk within the aforementioned thirty (30) days. If such junk vehicle or other junk is claimed by the owner, all reasonable charges for handling and storage shall be paid by the owner.

Section 4. Penalties. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall forfeit a sum of money not to exceed  $\cancel{200.00}$  plus court costs, and in default thereof be imprisoned in the county jail for a period not in excess of ten (10) days. Each day of said violation shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and publication.
