ORDINANCE NO 35-A 2017
AS AMENDED 9/13/2017

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING JUNK VEHICLES AND/OR ALL JUNK IN THE TOWN OF BROCKWAY:

WHEREAS, it is in the public health, safety and general welfare that certain regulations be adopted regarding junk vehicles and other junk in the Town,

NOW THEREFORE, THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF BROCKWAY, JAKCSON COUNTY, WISCONSIN DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. No person shall keep, house, store or place on premises owned, leased or controlled by that person in the Town of Brockway junk, such as scrap iron, junk vehicles, junk machinery, junk trailers, bottles, jugs, rags, broken glass, paper of any kind, scrap metal, or anything that might otherwise be considered junk or waste.

Refer to Section 17.40 (6) (a) of the Jackson County Zoning Ordinance to clarify "junk" without obtaining a land use permit for the operation of a "junk yard" and salvage yard. Storage of three (3) or more unlicensed or inoperable vehicles on the same premises shall be prima facie evidence of operation of a junk or salvage yard.

SECTION 2. Whenever the Town Officer shall find any such junk vehicle or other junk kept, housed or stored or placed on premises within the Town of Brockway, he shall serve notice on the property owner and/or owner of such junk to remove the same within (30) thirty days of said notice. If any junk vehicle or other junk is not removed within (30) thirty days of such notice, the Town shall cause such junk vehicle or other junk to be removed and the cost of such removal shall be charged to the property from which it is removed, such charges to be entered upon the tax roll as a special assessment as provided by the Wisconsin State Statutes.

SECTION 3. Penalties- penalties shall be charged according to Section 17.23 of the JACKSON COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and publication.
